Hazelbaker Foundation Donates \$10,000 To Summitville School

Ralph E. Hazelbaker, recent donar of a \$10,000 gift to Summitville School was born in Summitville the son of Alfred and Nellie Hazelbaker.

He and his brothers, Emerson and Louis, were graduates of Summitville High after completing 12 years in the Summitville school system.

Hazelbaker said his tenure at the Summitville school was very enjoyable and a very active time in his life. He was active in the Glee and Drama Clubs, basketball and baseball and was vice president of his class.

He won a special merit scholarship to Indiana University where he later met Billie Ettinger of Indianapolis, who was a fellow student at IU.

After spending two years in the navy, Billie and he were married in 1944 and he went on to finish college with a BS in business in 1951.

With a growing family, they moved to Ohio where he contin-

ued his studies at Ohio State receiving his Master of Business Degree in 1959.

Years have blessed them with seven children and 17 grandchildren.

He is president of Paradigm Corp., a company engaged in the development and management of long-term care centers and retirement centers in Ohio and five western states.

He is engaged in various construction activities and ownership and operation of a concrete products manufacturing company.

In 1985 Hazelbaker and his wife established the Hazelbaker Foundation, whose mission is to provide support for the arts, education and other humanities. The foundation is particularly concerned with providing supplements for educational opportunities for deserving students.

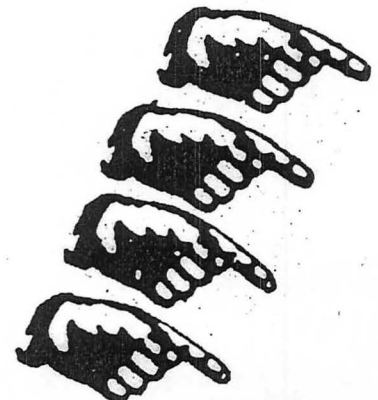
"The gift of \$10,000 which we made for the purchase of computer equipment and software, we believe will enable students and teachers to better achieve their educational and teaching objectives."

TO ANY PERSON EMPOWERED BY LAW TO SOLEMNIZE MARRIAGES IN THE COUNTY OF MADISON, GREETING:

You are hereby authorized to join together as Husband and Wife, Grant Hazelbaker
and Mint Richards, and of your Certificate of Marriage make due return within
three months, according to the laws of the State of Indiana.

WITNESS, Edmund Johnson, Clerk of our Madison Circuit Court, and the seal
thereof, affixed at the Clerk's office in Anderson, this 4th day of November, 1896

And afterwards, to wit: On the 13th day of November, 1896, the following
Certificate of Marriage was returned to the Clerk's office, to wit:

I, E. F. Johnson, hereby certify that, on the 4th day of
November, A. D. 1896, I duly joined in marriage Grant Hazelbaker
and Mint Richards, by authority of law and of a License from the Clerk of
Madison Circuit Court.

Given under my hand, this 4th day of November, A. D. 1896

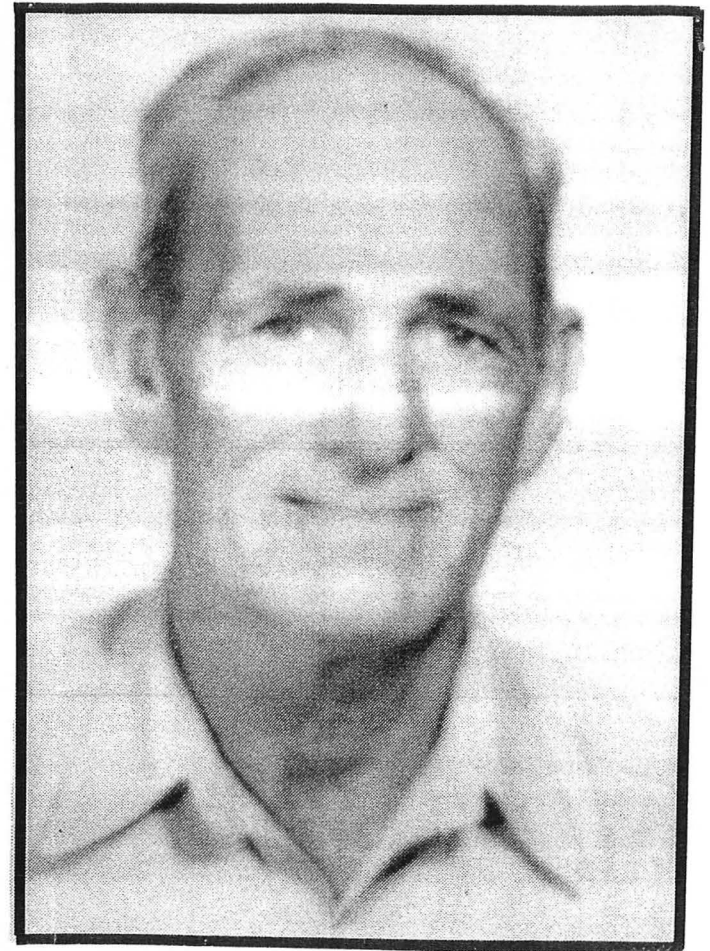
